PREPROPOSAL CONFERENCE

GENERAL: The Government will hold a preproposal conference at Robins Air Force Base, Georgia on 5 April 2004 beginning at 9:00 AM in the Conference Room in Building 702, 625 7th Street, Robins Air Force Base, Georgia 31098. All Offerors are strongly encouraged to attend this conference. The conference will be conducted in two parts. In the first part, the Government will hold an information session, at which time the Government will

explain the evaluation process and the key elements of the technical requirements. The Government will then conduct a site visit of the site designed for this project.

QUESTIONS/ANSWERS: The Government requests that questions be provided in writing in advance of the conference. Questions may be submitted via e-mail to leslie.a.zuniga@sas02.usace.army.mil. At the conference the Government will accept and attempt to answer additional written questions after advance questions have been addressed.

ENTERING ROBINS AIR FORCE BASE: Contractors are to allow adequate time to process through security checkpoint.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Attendees are responsible for their own travel and hotel accommodations.

A Value Engineering (VE) Study will be performed by the Government following receipt of the Contractor's 60% design submittal. The VE Team will consist of representatives from the Air Force, Savannah District Corps of Engineers and the Architect and Engineers under contract to the Savannah District Corps of Engineers. The proposals will be considered by the VE Team, with special emphasis on the Contractor's input as to how a proposal can be incorporated into its design and schedule. The VE proposals selected by the government for implementation will be presented to the Contractor as a Request For Proposal. The government and the contractor will negotiate any price adjustment necessary for those proposals to be incorporated into the contract. A bilateral modification to the contract will be issued under the Changes Clause. The contractor will retain full responsibility and liability for the work incorporated by the changes, in addition to all other work described in the contract. This VE process is intended to be accomplished in the full spirit of partnering.
